

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

REGARDING IMPORT OF COVID-19 VACCINE IN PAKISTAN

1) What is the procedure to apply for NOC to import COVID-19 vaccine in Pakistan as donation?

Any registered agency/organization/hospital in Pakistan can import COVID-19 vaccine on donation from any donating agency. Applicant needs to submit following documents for acquiring NOC to import COVID-19 vaccine as donation:

- i. Formal application on given format
(<https://www.dra.gov.pk/docs/Application%20for%20NOC%201.pdf>)
- ii. Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from country of origin
- iii. Certificate of analysis or Conformance (batch wise)
- iv. Certificate of donation from donor
- v. Copy of Packing list(s)
- vi. Copy of invoice(s)

2) What is the procedure to apply for NOC to import COVID-19 vaccine in Pakistan for hospitals/institutions?

Any hospital/institution (both public and private) in Pakistan can import COVID-19 vaccine for their exclusive use. Applicant needs to submit following documents for acquiring NOC to import COVID-19 vaccine for hospitals/institution:

- i. Formal application on given format
(<https://www.dra.gov.pk/docs/Application%20for%20NOC.pdf>)
- ii. Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from country of origin
- iii. Certificate of analysis or Conformance (batch wise)

3) Can I sell COVID-19 vaccine imported as donation or by any public or private hospital/institute?

No, COVID-19 vaccine imported for use in any public or private hospital/institute or as donation is not allowed in any form for retail sale in market. It shall be only and exclusively used in that particular premises under the supervision of healthcare professionals and record of vaccine administration shall be maintained.

4) I want import COVID-19 vaccine for personal use, what is the procedure?

COVID-19 vaccine can be imported for personal use. A Pakistani citizen with valid CNIC can apply online at given link (<http://public.dra.gov.pk/ie/noc/>), or by directly visiting DRAP office. Applicant needs to submit following documents for acquiring import NOC:

- i. Formal application
- ii. Valid prescription (duly signed and stamped by registered medical practitioner)
- iii. Copy of CNIC (patient)
- iv. Copy of CNIC (applicant)
