

Grant of NOC for import of unregistered / not available finished drugs for Personal Use

(The procedure for grant of NOC for export of registered finished drugs for Personal Use will be same with addition of provision of evidence of residence abroad i.e. CNIC / passport / visa / residential card.)

Name of a business process	Apply for grant of NOC for import of drugs for personal use
Related laws, rules, and regulations	The Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan Act, 2012 The Drugs Act, 1976 Rule 13 of the Drugs (Import & Export) Rules, 1976.
Process participant	Importer (Patient / near relative) DRAP
Input and criteria to enter/ begin the business process	Importer is a patient / near relative having a prescription (not older than 3 months from date of application) of drug to be imported by a qualified prescriber.
Activities and associated documentary requirements	<p>Process for grant of NOC for import of drugs for personal use</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicant applies for grant of NOC to import of unregistered / not available finished drugs for personal use. (Under rule 13 of the Drugs I&E rules, 1976, the quantity of any single drug shall not exceed average 100 doses or as may be considered reasonable by the licensing authority i.e. dose for 90 days). Applicant also attaches following supporting document: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of CNIC of applicant (if different from patient) • Copy of CNIC of patient • Prescription duly signed / stamped and PMDC number of physician. 2. Applicant submits the application to DRAP. 3. DRAP receives and scrutinizes the application with supporting documents as per checklist. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If application not compliant, DRAP returns the application with observation notes. 4. After successful verification, DRAP analyze the request for NOC issuance decision. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If request is rejected, DRAP informs the applicant. 5. If request is approved, DRAP issues NOC to import drug by patient. 6. Applicant receives the NOC to import drugs for personal use from DRAP.
Output criteria to exit the business process	NOC for import of drugs for personal use Validity: For particular consignment (one time) Legal Reference: Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan Act, 2012 , The Drugs Act, 1976 & Rule 13 of the Drugs (Import & Export) Rules, 1976
Time required to complete this business process	Minimum = Same day Maximum = 3 days
