

NOTIFICATION

S.R.O./33 (I)/2021.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Drugs Act, 1976 (XXXI of 1976), the Federal Government, being of the opinion that in the public interest so requires, is pleased to exempt the COVID-19 vaccines being imported for sale in hospitals and institutions, from the operation of section 12 of the said Act for a period of six months or till the market prices of those vaccines become available in order to proceed further as per Drug Pricing Policy-2018, whichever is earlier, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (a) the vaccines shall be registered or approved for emergency use authorization by the Registration Board of the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan; and
- (b) the vaccines shall not be sold or distributed in the market.
