DRUG PRICING POLICY-2018 BY DRUG REGULATORY AUTHORITY
OF PAKISTAN.**

The undersigned is directed to inform you that the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) has introduced a new online application submission platform to apply annual increase in Maximum Retail Prices (MRPs) of drugs under para 7 of Drug Pricing Policy-2018 to increase the operational efficiency and ease of doing business processes. This module/system is designed to simplify the processing of submitting application. It will enhance accessibility, reduce processing times, and ensure a smoother experience for all.

2. Any Pharmaceuticals manufacturer/importer who intends to avail increase linked with CPI may access this online module from July, 2025 to submit online calculations of Maximum Retail Prices (MRPs) of drugs included in NEML.
3. MIS Division along with the Costing & Pricing, Division, will conduct online training session for industry on online CPI module to address any technical queries raised by the participants. Online training is scheduled to be held on 21st May, 2025 at 10:30 am. Zoom link for training will be provided on 20th May, 2025.
4. You are advised to inform all member pharmaceutical companies regarding online training session and to participate in training as mentioned above.
